

## **ELECTIONS**

### **Once the city passes a resolution, does it stay in effect for future elections?**

Previously, it did not, but now it does. Act 1165 of 2003, Section 10, changed 14-42-206 to provide that such resolution shall remain in effect for the subsequent elections unless revoked by the city or town council. However, resolutions from prior years would probably be ineffective. In other words, if the council wishes to have primaries, it should pass another resolution to comply with the new statute, and then the new resolution would stay in effect for future elections.
